



## 2026 SLAS Summer Enrichment Program

Join us at Shanghai Livingston American School for the 2026 Summer Enrichment Program! This year's summer program caters to students who seek academic enrichment, English and Chinese language learning, fun sports-based activities, introduction to technology, and high school credit and non-credit courses.

Students enrolling in the Early Years and Primary, as well as secondary non-credit course summer school have the option in participating in all 6 weeks of summer school or they may also choose to enroll in less than 6 weeks. Each week will build up on the previous week's content.

### Summer School – Early Years Class Offerings

Nursery– PS (Age 2 – 3)	<b>SLAS Tiniest:</b> Tiniest is the program for our youngest students which will provide a dynamic and exciting educational experience for your child. The classes will be based on a variety of weekly themes to engage young minds in many learning opportunities. Through arts and crafts, music, stories, and play our Tiniest class will roam with ancient dinosaurs, explore outer space, and delve into many other fun topics, as well as taking a splash in the pool to cool down from the summer heat.	<b>HALF DAY</b> Tuition: <b>RMB 2750 / week</b>  <b>FULL DAY</b> Tuition: <b>RMB 3760 / week</b>
PK (Age 4 – 5)	<b>SLAS Minis:</b> The Minis program is for our students getting ready for primary school. Through weekly themes, your child will explore the world around them and work on their early reading and writing skills, as well as learning through arts and crafts, music, and play. Each day, students will engage in a variety of fun opportunities to learn, with literacy and STEM classes, specials classes, and twice a week getting a trip to the pool. Students will end this course with an expanded vocabulary, stronger listening and speaking skills and a boost in their English skill confidence.	



## Summer School – Primary Class Offerings

Morning Primary Programs(K-G5) M-F (8:30 – 12:20)		June 22 – July 31 (6 Weeks)
Beginners	<p><b>English Adventures</b> Be immersed in the English language while developing <b>listening</b>, <b>speaking</b>, <b>reading</b>, and <b>writing skills</b> through fun, interactive activities. Students will strengthen reading comprehension and overall understanding through whole-group, small-group, and independent literacy experiences centered on a weekly theme and guiding question. Collaboration with peers promotes social skills and confidence as students share ideas and learn together. Throughout the course, students grow into proficient communicators, creative thinkers, compassionate citizens, and confident individuals as they explore English and the world around them.</p>	Tuition: <b>RMB 2795 / week</b>
Intermediate to advanced	<p><b>Summer Prep (Intermediate to Advanced)</b> This Summer Prep course introduces students to a wide range of learning experiences designed to strengthen both academic and social language skills. Instruction extends beyond books to include guided discussions, creative research presentations, and collaborative activities, allowing students to actively practice new skills. Through frequent opportunities to speak and present, students will build confidence in oral communication and presentation skills.</p> <p>Students in the intermediate to advanced level should be able to read and write simple sentences in English, answer literal comprehension questions, and correctly use present and past tense. By the end of the course, students will demonstrate improved fluency, stronger presentation abilities, and increased confidence using English in academic and social settings.</p>	Tuition: <b>RMB 2795 / week</b>
Grades K – 5	<p><b>Chinese Language Learning (Level I to Level III):</b> This program offers Chinese language learners an opportunity to immerse themselves in the target language in an innovative and interactive way.</p> <p>The Chinese Language Learning course will be separated into three classes of: Beginning, Intermediate and Advanced levels.</p> <p><b>Level I Beginners:</b> Students will begin through a basic introduction to Chinese vocabulary and grammar through the use of games and activities to stimulate the young minds.</p> <p><b>Level II Intermediate:</b> Students will strengthen their foundation of Chinese and learn to use the target language to talk about themselves, their friends and families and all of their favorite activities.</p> <p><b>Level III Advanced:</b> Students will be encouraged to use Chinese to tackle real life situations, ordering in restaurants, asking for directions, debating about certain issues and giving presentations.</p>	Tuition: <b>RMB 1520 / week</b>

## Primary Course Description

### Afternoon Primary Program:

**Arts and Crafts:** This course delves into your student's creative and artistic side. Students will be in touch with their imaginative side making fantastic art and craft projects this summer!

**Shanghai Chess Academy:** Conducted by the SCA Chess Academy, the program focuses on showing students that chess is both educational and entertaining. The SCA signature curriculum is divided into different levels of advancement to fit a wide range of ages and experience.

**Pottery:** Classic pottery class taught by a highly experienced teacher.

**Dance:** Hip Hop and Contemporary.

**3D Pen Art:** With the use of child safe, advanced 3D pens, students will learn how 3D printing technology works and create beautiful works of art. This class introduces them to the cutting-edge world of 3D printing and challenges them to produce a variety of objects such as eye glasses, cars, etc. All supplies will be provided.

**English in Motion:** This high-energy English immersion class is perfect for learners who love to move! English in Motion builds vocabulary, listening comprehension, and speaking confidence through active play, songs, and team challenges. Each week features a fun theme—like animals, sports, or directions—paired with movement-based games, obstacle courses, and interactive storytelling. Students will learn to follow instructions, use new words in context, and express themselves through physical activity. It's the perfect blend of language learning and lively fun!



**Computer Fun:** Join us for fun and learning with the computer. Students will learn to use KidPix 3D (an application for creating 3D content) and Microsoft Office. Students will learn how to create Excel, word documents and PowerPoint presentations. Students will create original 3D content. Education games will be used to teach typing skills.

**Sports:** SLAS is equipped with a full functional track and field, soccer field, basketball courts, tennis court and play grounds.

Students will be able to engage in many fun activities and games such as soccer tournaments, Capture the Flag, Marco Polo, etc.

**Mad Scientist:** Sharpen your scientific investigative skills this summer through the Mad Scientist course! Join us for a summer filled with fun, hands-on science experiments from exploring colors through tie-dye, volcano eruptions, growing crystals and more.

**Cooking:** This is our most popular class at SLAS. This course introduces students to food preparation and storage as well as various cuisines from around the globe. This is truly a class where kids have fun and get to eat their creations.

## Summer School – Secondary Class Offerings (G6-G12; non-credit)

Morning Secondary Programs M-F (8:30 – 12:20)		June 22–July 31 (6 weeks)
Gr. 6 – 8 Gr. 9 – 12 8:30 – 12:20	<b>English Language Learning:</b> Taught by an experienced credentialed teacher, this ESL course is an intensive, fast-paced class focused on strengthening the student's English foundation. Students will concentrate on correct usage of grammar, building vocabulary, enhancing oral skills and improving reading and listening comprehension.	Tuition: <b>RMB 2990/ week</b>
Afternoon Secondary Programs M-F (13:05 – 15:30, Period 1&2 )		June 22–July 31 (6 weeks)
Gr. 9-12 13:05 – 15:30	<b>Intensive Writing Workshop:</b> This course is designed to help the ESL student improve their writing skills in order to be successful in the regular English classes. Students will write persuasive, expository and mini research papers. Students will be introduced to the necessary skills used to write research papers such as note cards, outlines, citing sources. This course is for ESL 2 and above.	Tuition: <b>RMB 1520/ week</b>
Gr. 6 – 9 13:05 – 15:30	<b>Algebra Readiness Workshop:</b> This course is designed to boost basic algebra skill set while simultaneously reinforcing their reading and writing skills.	Tuition: <b>RMB 1520/ week</b>
Gr. 6 –12 13:05 – 15:30	<b>Intensive Chinese: (Not for credit)</b> This course prepares Chinese language learners through an immersion in the target language. They will focus on building strong vocabulary and grammar foundations as well as develop a professional usage of the target language. *Note: Students must seek approval from current teacher or counselor before taking any credit course. A minimum of three (3) students is required to open a class. Student taking HS credit courses may only be absent for one class and still receive the HS credit. No “make up” time will be allowed for students who miss more than one day.*



## Applications and Admissions

Our Summer Programs are open to students from nursery level (SLAS Tiniest) to those entering Grade 12. Admission to our Summer Programs is granted to students on a first-come, first-serve basis. Applications must be accompanied by all fees (tuition, lunch, bus, etc.) in order to process the application.

The application deadline is **June 12, 2026**. Applications for all students in all programs must be received by this deadline. Any application submitted after this time will only be accepted if space remains in the requested classes.

## Tuitions, Fees and Refunds

Pricing for SLAS Summer Programs is on a per-course basis. Each course has a separate tuition, and students have the option of enrolling in a lunch program for an additional fee. Tuition includes any materials used in the classroom. Families will receive a 5% sibling discount if they have two or more students attending SLAS summer school.

**Sibling Discount:** There will be a 5% discount on tuition from the 2nd child who signs up from the same family. The lower of the students' tuition fees will receive the 5% reduction. (For example, if a student enrolls in a program costing 2800rmb, and the other sibling enrolls on a program costing 3200rmb, the 5% reduction will be applied to the student enrolled in the 2800rmb program. **(High School credit courses are excluded from sibling discount offers)**

**SLAS students:** SLAS students will receive a 15% discount from tuition. This discount may be applied on top of the sibling discount. **(High School credit courses, "Primary Intensive English Reading and Writing Workshop" are excluded from SLAS discount offers)**

Upper-grade students may be able to keep certain books as noted by the instructor at the end of the session. Lost or damaged school-owned books will need to be purchased by the student before certifications or grades can be released. Some classes may require textbook deposit.

The Summer Programs staff reserves the right to cancel or combine any courses that do not meet a minimum number of enrollments. Such decisions will be made no later than: **June 12, 2026**. Students enrolled in a class that is cancelled may either receive a full refund or may select another class or program.

**No refunds in tuition or transportation fees will be given for withdrawal requests received after June 12, 2026. Students who enroll after the June 12, 2026 deadline will not be eligible for a refund. Lunch refunds will only be provided with a written notice at least one week prior. In the event of bad weather requiring the school to close, a refund will not be issued.**

## Lunch

A warm lunch will be provided each day. All Early Years students are given two snacks each day, while elementary school students receive refreshments during their daily morning breaks. Lunch is 35 RMB / day.

\*1: Students attending the Early years program (SLAS Tiniest and SLAS Minis: half day / full day) must order lunch or bring a sack lunch from home.\*2: Students attending only the morning session for primary and above may NOT purchase school lunch.

**Lunch: RMB 175 per week.**

**For credit course applicant, lunch fee is RMB 350 per 10-day session.**

## Transportation

Bus service will be provided for students in the summer program including a pick-up and drop-off, once in the morning (from the designated pick-up area to school) and once at the end of the afternoon session (from school to the designated drop-off) There will be no pick-ups for students participating in afternoon only courses.
